The 2005 Carmignano Riserva from Tenuta Le Farnete is a dark, earthy wine loaded with black cherries, wild herbs, spices and licorice. This full-bodied, generous Carmignano boasts notable intensity and length. Stylistically it is perhaps a bit untamed, but I loved the wine for its exuberant personality. The Carmignano Riserva is 80% Sangiovese and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, and was aged in French oak barrels. This is a terrific effort. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2015.

The 2006 Chianti Montalbano Riserva (100% Sangiovese) is soft and harmonious in its dark red cherries, earthiness, tobacco and spices. This plump, juicy Chianti offers excellent length and an undeniably attractive personality. My preference would be to drink the wine on the young side, while the fruit is still vibrant. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2014.

These are two delicious, racy reds from Tenuta Pierazzuoli, a small family-run domaine located in the Montalbano district outside Florence.
